MyVeteran Communities bring together local Veteran service providers, resources, advocates, and other stakeholders to <u>improve outcomes</u> for Veterans, Service members, and their families.

MyVeteran Communities will be stood up in all 50 states and US territories.

VA may be the catalyst for community movements, but each community owns and leads the effort.

What does a MyVeteran Community do?

A MyVeteran Community drives a shared understanding among stakeholders of the complex challenges that Veterans and transitioning Service Members face and leverages its collective strengths to improve the Veteran experience.

VetsLink Update

Mission: Provide timely regional resource information to Veterans 24/7/365.

Why: 180K+ Vets in region who need quick access to information regarding the resources available in the Greater Miami Valley

Accomplishments:

- Sponsorship of VetsLink launch provided by multiple companies in region
- Annual Golf Tournament hosted by Rafi Rodriguez to benefit VetsLink
- Hired Veteran call-center specialists to answer VetsLink line
- Collected and vetted resource agencies from around the region to include in VetsLink resources database
- United Way 211 website updated to incorporate VetsLink
- Created VetsLink dashboard for United Way website to indicate recent needs of Veterans

Top Veteran Needs – Dayton.211counts.org

- Rent assistance
- Food
- Electric Bill assistance

Unmet Veteran Needs – Financial assistance/Hotel Vouchers/Household repairs, goods



Alzheimer's Military Task Force

- * Mission: Build sustainable relationships to improve services to Military and Veterans with perpentia.
 - Why: 180K+ Vets in region; 60% higher risk of dementia based on PTSD and TBL

Accomplishments:

- WPCU Sunshine Community Fund Grant
- Built task force– VA; Ohio Department of Veterans Services; County Veteran Services Offices; Ohio's Mospice, Alz Assoc; WPAFB
- Built video to educate VA visitors about the Military Task Force
- * Built robust referral system for WPAFB, VA, Ohio's Hospice and Alz Assoc
- Trained Speakers Bureau who can education local Veterans Groups
- Conducted training sessions for VA, Ohio's Hospice and WPAFB physicians
- Worked to establish earlier dementia assessments in local primary care groups
- Conducted training sessions for local Veterans Groups
- Attended events around the region to educate community on MTF mission
- Participated in Walk to End Alz, with MTF t-shirts for sale
- Participated as speakers/panels in local conferences
- Published multiple newspaper articles in local papers regarding MTF work,
- Published article in Maria Schriver's Womens Alzheimers Movement website and social media
- Advocated for legislation to mandate training on Dementia for First Responders in Ohio
- Multiple VAs in Ohio working with Alz Assoc on Age Friendly designations
- Hosted Virtual Workshop on Veterans and Dementia (Ohio, WV, Michigan)


